

Training and funding opportunities for women

ACCREDITED COURSES

These courses are generally studied alongside men who are training to be pastors, and are intended to equip students for a lifetime of fruitful ministry.

Part-time non-residential study. Includes specialist women's ministry track.

These courses are generally shorter and focussed on specific ministry skills. They may be appropriate to equip women for part-time, volunteer and short-term ministry roles.
